Shipping Home Grown Citrus Fruit from Florida

2020 - 2021 Season

The U.S. Department of Agriculture-Animal and Plant Health Inspection Services (USDA-APHIS) and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) has guarantined the entire state of Florida for citrus canker and sweet orange scab, along with portions of Charlotte, Collier, Glades, Hendry, Lee and Polk Counties for citrus black spot. The guarantines are to prevent movement of these serious plant diseases out of Florida (and portions of Florida quarantined for citrus black spot) to other citrus producing areas of the United States and its territories. However, scientific studies have determined that citrus fruit processed in a commercial packinghouse under an APHIS compliance agreement renders the fruit highly unlikely to spread these diseases. During the commercial packing process, fruit must be washed, brushed, disinfested, treated, and waxed. The fruit must be packed into shipping containers marked with a USDA-APHIS certificate and be free of leaves. stems, or other regulated plant material. Fruit that cannot meet the waxed and treated conditions above may be shipped under a USDA-APHIS limited permit.

Citrus trees, leaves and other citrus plant parts continue to pose a high risk of spreading these diseases, and therefore cannot be moved to other states.
